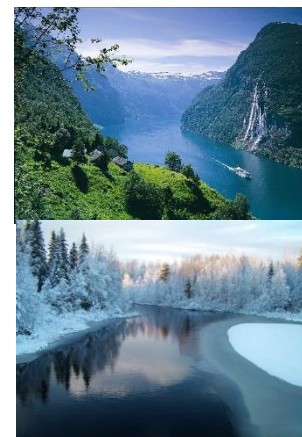

Two composers unshakably identified with the countries of their birth provide the feast for this concert.

Edvard Grieg, steeped in the spirit of the folk music of his native Norway, wrote Peer Gynt to accompany Ibsen's play of the same name. The programme includes one extract in each half.

His Piano Concerto, an instant and lasting success, has a never to be forgotten opening, made even more recognisable by the Morecambe and Wise sketch with André (Preview) Previn – in 1971!!

Sibelius is often credited with having helped Finland to develop a national identity during its struggle for independence from Russia. The patriotic finale of Finlandia, "Finland Awakes", meant that the work had to be performed under alternative names until independence was finally secured 20 years later in 1920.

We have reserved seats in the Rear Stalls at £19 with no booking charge, for this concert at the Royal Festival Hall. There will be independent travel; the Festival Hall is a short walk from Waterloo Station.
