Tuesday, 29 October – TUDOR LONDON WALK
with Ian Bevan

In September 1666, four-fifths of the City of London was destroyed in the Great Fire; subsequent development has consumed most of the rest. To follow on from his 'Tea and Talk' on Friday, 11 October, **Ian Bevan** will take us through the heart of the City pointing out the sites of some of the features, which the Tudor monarchs would have known – Blackfriars Abbey, the King's Wardrobe, St Paul's Cathedral and more.



Our walk will last about two hours. The area is flat and the walks between stops should be no more than 15 minutes. Our final stop will be at Smithfield Market, where there is one of the few Tudor structures left in the City.

We will travel on the train to Blackfriars station (via Wimbledon or Sutton – train time to be advised) where Ian will meet us. The walk will end near the Museum of London; Ian will show us where we can get the No 76 bus direct to Waterloo for our homeward journey.
